PLASTINDIA 2026 – POST-SHOW REPORT **New Delhi, February 5-10, 2026**

The eleventh edition of the international triennial exhibition PLASTINDIA took place from February 5 to 10, 2026 in New Delhi, c/o the renamed Bharat Mandapam fairgrounds (formerly Pragati Maidan).

As usual, it was organized by Plastindia Foundation, with the support of Government of India and overseas Associates Messe Düsseldorf, Adsale and EUROMAP patronage. Messe Düsseldorf took care of the participation of the European and North American exhibitors, whereas Adsale of the Chinese and Taiwanese ones, whilst Beauty Sky coordinated the Middle Eastern presence.

According to estimates, without official details by Plastindia Foundation, here below a list of country pavilions that attended the show:

- Austria
- China
- France
- Germany
- Italy
- Taiwan
- UK.

According to the organizers, the net area occupied amounted to 75,000 sqm (versus 50,000 in 2023); a further 20,000 sqm waiting list was set up.

Exhibitors were over 2,000 from 80 countries - versus 1,400 from 30 countries in 2023 - in 12 halls, mainly devoted to machinery manufacturers, as well as to raw materials and to semi-finished and finished products and services.

As far as visitors are concerned, the organizer estimated an affluence of 600,000 people compared to 250,000 in 2023.

PLASTINDIA will take place again in New Delhi, in February 2028, thus changing its frequency, from triennial to biennial.
